Tryouts

Tryouts for Varsity/Junior Varsity synchronized teams and Varsity Individual will take place on 11/2/18. Team placements will be announced the following week.

Season & Practices

Our season runs mid November and ends with our ice show in early March. Practice starts November 12th. Friday is the day the entire team practices, regardless of placement. You can expect to skate an additional one to two days if participating on a synchronized team and/or on an individual team.

The competition will be held in El Segundo, CA. The team will travel together with the coaches and parent chaperones. The competition dates are 2/22-2/24. The team travel details will be shared. Parents are welcome to come cheer on the team but are expected to make their own travel arrangements. Since hotels book fast, we will have a block of rooms available at a later date. Estimated Cost: \$850-\$900 (includes hotel, flight, ground transportation, food, and team events)
